1. Inventory of Research Studies
 - Inventory of existing, proposed and pipelined researches of various research institutions
 - Posting of existing research studies in the RDC website and linked with the concerned research institutions
2. Advocacy/Implementation
 - Dissemination of the priority research areas to various agencies, institutions, academe, etc
 - Conduct of advocacy campaigns (forums, conferences, seminars, meetings, IEC materials)
 - Promote areas of convergence and collaborations among research institutions
 - Linkages between research institutions and fund sources
3. Monitoring
 - Establishment of an on-line database system of researches, including sharing and analysis of research studies
 - Assessment of the researches conducted aligned with the RDRA
 - Conduct of Research Utilization Forum

The Calabarzon Regional Development Research Agenda (RDRA) 2014-2016 defines the research gaps identified in the Regional Development Plan 2011-2016.

The RDRA contains broad topics of researches that need urgent convergent or individual actions from research institutions critical in attaining inclusive growth and in enhancing the region's role as economic and business hub. It aims to guide various research institutions and partners of the priority researchable areas to address the issues, concerns, and challenges affecting the region's economic drivers, and further spur sustainable development and innovations towards improving the productivity, competitiveness and inclusive growth of the region.

The preparation of the RDRA is an initiative of the Regional Development Council (RDC) through the Regional Research Committee (RRC) to provide research directions in support to the development efforts in the region.

The RDC-RRC encourages the academe, research institutions and development partners to focus their researches on the Calabarzon priority research areas.
